**Team Competition** One team consists of three boys and one girl **from each category**. Mixed teams with other nations are allowed to be build and start in a class out of competition.

**Reimbursement** **4 Athletes**. For these 4 athletes accommodation and meals will be organized and covered from 7th (lunch) to 9th (lunch).  
For the other athletes and two trainers per team there will be offered and organized a package for 80,00 € per day.  
This package must be paid in cash or by ec-card at the competition office.  
The information about accommodation will be handed to the teams after registration.

## Liability

### 1. Risk assessment and personal responsibility of the participants:

In the DSV-active declaration for the receipt of their starting pass, the participants have stated in detail that they are aware of the competition-specific risks and dangers and that they accept them. To be further informed that in this respect you may suffer damage to life or limb while exercising your chosen ski discipline. After all, they have undertaken to carry out their own risk assessment to determine whether, based on their individual skills, they are confident enough to cope with the difficulties of the route or facility and are also obliged to point out any safety deficiencies they have recognized. With their start they express on the one hand the suitability of the route and on the other hand they are able to meet the demands of the route. In addition, they have expressly confirmed in the active declaration that they are responsible for the material they use. These declarations are also binding for this competition.

### 2. Fault of the organizer and his vicarious agents:

The participant in the competition accepts, if he suffers damage in the competition and is of the opinion that the responsible organizer or his vicarious agents are at fault for this, that they are only liable for damage to property in the case of intent or gross negligence. This declaration applies also for the legal successor of the athlete. The participant further declares that he is ready to familiarize himself with the respective competition regulations. If a third party suffers damage through his participation in the competition, he accepts that he alone can bear any liability. It is therefore in your own interest to have sufficient insurance coverage.

## General Data Protection Regulation:

### Data protection declaration for sporting events / competitions

1. We, the Skiclub Ruhpolding, represented by the 1st board, are responsible for processing your personal data. Please address all your requests, suggestions and questions to: [info@wintersportbuero.de](mailto:info@wintersportbuero.de) or the mentioned entry address.

2. When registering for the above sporting event, we collect the following categories of data or the following personal data from you: personal master data (first name, last name, year of birth, if applicable nationality, club membership) and contact details (Telephone number, email address) from you directly or from your regional association when you register through them or are reported to us by them.

3. Your data will be processed in order to fulfill the sports event contract to which you are a party. To do this, it is necessary to identify you in order to check the payment of the entry fee, your entry authorization and the existence of insurance coverage and, if necessary, to contact you for any queries, assign you a start number, the admission, the competition, the accompanying program, the accommodation and / or to organize and carry out catering and other event-related services. Only your personal master data (first and last name, year of birth) and your club membership are published for the publication of lists of results and award ceremonies.
